

Michael Charles Sheppard, MB, PhD, FRCP

Professor Sheppard is William Withering Professor of Medicine and Pro-Vice Chancellor at the University of Birmingham. After earning MBChB (Honours) and PhD from the University of Cape Town (South Africa), Professor Sheppard continued his studies at the University of Birmingham, from where he was awarded the degrees of MRCP, FRCP and FMedSci. He was elected Founder Fellow of the Academy of Medical Sciences in 1998.

Professor Sheppard's clinical interests focus on diagnosis and management of pituitary disease, particularly acromegaly, and thyroid disease, notably hyperthyroidism and thyroid cancer. His research has focussed on the epidemiology and management of pituitary disease, pituitary tumour pathogenesis, evaluation of innovative therapies for acromegaly, the outcome of thyrotoxicosis, and the management of thyroid cancer.

His national and international responsibilities include Treasurer, Council Member and past Chair Clinical Committee of the UK Society for Endocrinology, past Chair Royal College of Physicians SAC Endocrinology and Diabetes, Member of the Executive Committee of the European Society of Endocrinology, Chair of the 2005 ECE Programme Organizing Committee, and Board Chair of European Journal of Endocrinology.
